AN ACT INCREASING THE TIME PERIOD FOR A TOWING COMPANY TO SELL A TOWED MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That subparagraphs (A) and (B) of subdivision (3) of subsection (e) of section 14-150 of the general statutes be amended to permit a towing company to sell a motor vehicle that has been taken into custody and stored after forty-five days, instead of fifteen days, if the market value of such motor vehicle does not exceed one thousand five hundred dollars, or sixty days, instead of forty-five days, if the market value of such motor vehicle exceeds one thousand five hundred dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the time period for a towing company to sell a towed motor vehicle and align with the time periods established by neighboring states.
