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AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYMENT AND AFFORDABLE HOUSING PILOT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2025*) (a) For the purposes described in subsection (b) of this section, the State Bond Commission shall have the power from time to time to authorize the issuance of bonds of the state in one or more series and in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate ____ dollars.
 - (b) The proceeds of the sale of such bonds, to the extent of the amount stated in subsection (a) of this section, shall be used by the Department of Housing for the purpose of financing approved projects to create employment opportunities in the construction industry to develop affordable housing.
 - (c) All provisions of section 3-20 of the general statutes, or the exercise of any right or power granted thereby, that are not inconsistent with the provisions of this section are hereby adopted and shall apply to all bonds authorized by the State Bond Commission pursuant to this section. 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Sec. 2. (Effective July 1, 2025) (a) The Commissioner of Housing shall establish a one-year pilot program to provide funds, utilizing the proceeds of the sale of bonds pursuant to section 1 of this act, for proposed projects that create employment opportunities in the construction industry to develop affordable housing.

(b) On and after July 1, 2025, the Commissioner of Housing, or any program administrator the commissioner may designate, shall accept applications, in a form specified by the commissioner, from a project sponsor for financing under the program. The commissioner shall establish approval criteria for any proposed project submitted by a project sponsor. Such approval criteria shall require that any project sponsor secure coinvestment funding in the proposed project by a union pension fund or comingled fund of union pension fund investments with a demonstrated record of successful investment in the construction of affordable housing. Such union pension fund investment shall

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- require the inclusion of a project labor agreement and a commitment to workforce training by adhering to state-registered apprenticeship standards and apprenticeship readiness programs.
 - (c) All housing built with funding from the program shall remain permanently affordable, through the use of restrictive covenants or other means selected by the commissioner.
 - (d) Not later than six months following the date of completion of the pilot program, the Commissioner of Housing shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing. Such report shall include an analysis of the efficacy of the pilot program administered pursuant to this section and any recommendations for legislation to expand such program or implement such program on a permanent basis.
