***AN ACT CONCERNING CONNECTICUT WING CIVIL AIR PATROL
YOUTH CAMPS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 19a-421 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*
3 *1, 2025*):

4 (a) (1) No person shall establish, conduct or maintain a youth camp
5 without a license issued by the office, except the Connecticut Wing Civil
6 Air Patrol within the Department of Emergency Services and Public
7 Protection may establish, conduct or maintain a youth camp without a
8 license.

9 (2) Applications for such license shall be made in writing at least
10 thirty days prior to the opening of the youth camp on forms provided
11 and in accordance with procedures established by the commissioner
12 and shall be accompanied by a fee of eight hundred fifteen dollars or, if
13 the applicant is a nonprofit, nonstock corporation or association, a fee of
14 three hundred fifteen dollars or, if the applicant is a day camp affiliated
15 with a nonprofit organization, for no more than five days duration and

16 for which labor and materials are donated, no fee.

17 (3) All such licenses shall be valid for a period of one year from the
18 date of issuance unless surrendered for cancellation or suspended or
19 revoked by the commissioner for violation of this chapter or any
20 regulations adopted under section 19a-428 and shall be renewable upon
21 payment of an eight-hundred-fifteen-dollar license fee or, if the licensee
22 is a nonprofit, nonstock corporation or association, a three-hundred-
23 fifteen-dollar license fee or, if the applicant is a day camp affiliated with
24 a nonprofit organization, for no more than five days duration and for
25 which labor and materials are donated, no fee.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that the Connecticut Wing Civil Air Patrol within the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection may establish, conduct or maintain a youth camp without a license.
