## Substitute Bill No. 1385

## AN ACT REQUIRING THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF FLOOD INSURANCE COVERAGE OPTIONS FOR OWNERS OF RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Insurance Commissioner shall 2 conduct a study of flood insurance coverage options for owners of residential or commercial property in this state and evaluate practices 3 4 to increase access to and awareness of such coverage options for owners 5 of residential or commercial property. Not later than February 1, 2026, 6 the Insurance Commissioner shall submit a report, in accordance with 7 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint 8 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of 9 matters relating to insurance on the findings of such study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
