AN ACT CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION OF STATE GRANT COMMITMENTS FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS AND REVISIONS TO THE SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Administrative 2 Services, having reviewed applications for state grants for public school 3 building projects in accordance with section 10-283 of the general 4 statutes on the basis of priorities for such projects and standards for 5 school construction established by the State Board of Education, and 6 having prepared a listing of all such eligible projects ranked in order of 7 priority, as determined by said commissioner together with the amount 8 of the estimated grant with respect to each eligible project, and having 9 submitted such listing of eligible projects, prior to December 15, 2024, to 10 a committee of the General Assembly established under section 10-283a 11 of the general statutes for the purpose of reviewing such listing, is 12 hereby authorized to enter into grant commitments on behalf of the state 13 in accordance with said section 10-283a with respect to the priority 14 listing of such projects and in such estimated amounts as approved by 15 said committee prior to February 1, 2025, as follows:

Sec. 2. Subsection (e) of section 10-285a of the general statutes is
repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*,
2025):

21 (e) (1) If an elementary school building project for a new building or 22 for the expansion of an existing building includes space for an early 23 childhood care and education program that provides services for 24 children from birth to five years, the percentage determined pursuant to 25 this section for the entire school building project shall be increased by 26 fifteen percentage points, but shall not exceed one hundred per cent. [, 27 for the portion of the building used primarily for such purpose.] 28 Recipient districts shall maintain such early childhood care and 29 education program for at least ten years.

30 (2) The percentage determined pursuant to this section for any school 31 building project for a building or facility that will be used exclusively by 32 a local or regional board of education for an early childhood care and 33 education program that provides services for children from birth to five 34 years shall be increased by fifteen percentage points, but shall not 35 exceed one hundred per cent. Recipient districts shall maintain such 36 early childhood care and education program for at least twenty years.

Sec. 3. Section 10-285a of the general statutes is amended by adding
subsection (l) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2025*):

(NEW) (l) (1) If a school building project for a new building or for the
expansion of an existing building includes a designated space for a

41 special education program that provides services for students receiving 42 special education and related services, the percentage determined 43 pursuant to this section for the entire school building project shall be 44 increased by fifteen percentage points, but shall not exceed one hundred 45 per cent. Recipient districts shall maintain such designated space for the 46 special education program for at least ten years.

(2) The percentage determined pursuant to this section for any school
building project for a building or facility that will be used exclusively by
a local or regional board of education for a special education program
that provides services for students receiving special education and
related services shall be increased by fifteen percentage points, but shall
not exceed one hundred per cent. Recipient districts shall maintain such
special education program for at least twenty years.
