AN ACT PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION IN SERVICES FUNDED UNDER MEDICAID.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Social
2 Services shall require, as a condition of receiving Medicaid
3 reimbursement, that a provider agree, in writing, not to discriminate
4 against any persons whose rights are protected under chapter 814c of
5 the general statutes. The commissioner may withhold Medicaid
6 payments from any provider determined to have engaged in
7 discrimination under the provisions of chapter 814c of the general
8 statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
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Statement of Purpose:

To require a provider who is reimbursed for services under Medicaid to agree, in writing, not to discriminate against persons whose rights are

protected under state law as a condition of receiving Medicaid reimbursement.
