RESOLUTION AMENDING THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE CERTAIN SIGNATURES FOR EMERGENCY CERTIFIED BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 require any emergency certified bill or emergency certified resolution to
- 3 be signed by the president pro tempore of the Senate, speaker of the
- 4 House of Representatives, minority leader of the Senate and minority
- 5 leader of the House of Representatives before any such bill or resolution
- 6 can be filed.

Statement of Purpose:

To amend the state constitution to require certain legislative leader signatures for emergency certified bills and resolutions.
