RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO ESTABLISH TERM LIMITS FOR LEGISLATORS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the Constitution of the state be amended to provide that a
- 2 person may serve not more than six terms as a state senator and not
- 3 more than six terms as a state representative.

Statement of Purpose:

To limit legislators to six terms in each chamber of the General Assembly.
