## RESOLUTION AMENDING THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO PROHIBIT LEGISLATIVE LIAISONS FROM THE HOUSE AND SENATE FLOOR DURING SESSIONS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to prohibit legislative liaisons employed by an executive branch agency or a legislative commission from the floor of (1) the House of Representatives on a day when the House is in session, or (2) the Senate on a day when the Senate is in session, except for a public hearing on the floor of the House or Senate or a liaison invited to the floor of the House or Senate for purposes of a ceremony or recognition.

## Statement of Purpose:

To subject agency liaisons to the same rules as lobbyists regarding their presence on the House and Senate floor.
