RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION REQUIRING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF TWO-THIRDS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEMBERSHIP FOR THE PASSAGE OF SPECIAL SESSION LEGISLATION.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 require an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the membership of each
- 3 house of the General Assembly to enact any public or special act during
- 4 a special session of the General Assembly.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that all legislation passed during a special session obtain a two-thirds affirmative vote of the membership of each house for passage.
