## RESOLUTION CONDEMNING THE PROVISIONS OF THE TREATY OF HARTFORD OF 1638 THAT SOUGHT TO ERADICATE THE PEQUOT CULTURAL IDENTITY.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That this Assembly condemn the provisions of the Treaty of Hartford, 2 an agreement between the English inhabitants in Connecticut and the 3 Narragansett and Mohegan Tribes in 1638, that sought to eradicate the 4 Pequot cultural identity by prohibiting the Pequots from returning to 5 their lands, abolishing their tribal name and forcing them to assimilate
- 6 into the Mohegan and the Narragansett Tribes and the remaining
- 7 members of the Pequot Tribe to be sold into slavery or killed.

## Statement of Purpose:

To condemn the provisions of the Treaty of Hartford of 1638 that sought to eradicate the Pequot cultural identity.
