

Senate Bill No. 1259

Special Act No. 25-8

AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF STRATEGIES TO SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGE STUDENT ENROLLMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT, WATERBURY CAMPUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The University of Connecticut shall study and make recommendations regarding strategies to support and encourage student enrollment at The University of Connecticut, Waterbury Campus. Such study shall include, but need not be limited to, a plan offering dual enrollment programs and online course offerings and consideration of (1) the operation of such programs and course offerings, and (2) workforce development initiatives at said campus.

(b) Not later than February 1, 2026, The University of Connecticut shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to commerce and higher education and employment advancement in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.
