Special Act No. 25-23

AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEVELS OF STAFFING FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection shall prepare a report concerning the environmental conservation police of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection. Such report shall examine: (1) The number of conservation police officers and special conservation police officers appointed during the preceding four calendar years, (2) statistics on calls for service by such conservation police officers during such fouryear period, (3) statistics on the enforcement of all applicable statutory and regulatory provisions by such conservation police officers during such four-year period, and (4) benchmarking of such staffing information and enforcement statistics to other comparable states, as available and appropriate. Not later than February 1, 2026, the department shall submit such report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment and public safety.
