"AN ACT CONCERNING HOUSING AND THE NEEDS OF HOMELESS PERSONS."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
 internal references accordingly:

"Sec. 501. (*Effective October 1, 2025*) Notwithstanding any provision of
title 12 of the general statutes, commencing with fiscal year July 1, 2028,
no municipality shall increase its property tax in an amount greater than
two per cent annually or the rate of inflation as calculated biannually,
whichever is greater.

8 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force to
9 study the potential ramifications and make recommendations regarding
10 repealing municipal mandates.

11 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

12 (1) Two appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

13 (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;

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14	(3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of			
15	Representatives;			
16	(4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;			
17	(5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of			
18	Representatives;			
19	(6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate; and			
20	(7) The Commissioner of Housing, or the commissioner's designee.			
21	(c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),			
22	(2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member			
23	of the General Assembly.			
24	(d) All initial appointments to the task force shall be made not later			
25	than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall			
26	be filled by the appointing authority.			
27	(e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president pro			
28	tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task force from			
29	among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons shall schedule			
30	the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not later than sixty			
31	days after the effective date of this section.			
32	(f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the			
33	(f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing			
34	shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.			
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35	(g) Not later than February 1, 2026, the task force shall submit a report			
36	on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of			
37	the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing,			
38	in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.			
39	The task force shall terminate on the date that it submits such report or			
40	February 1, 2026, whichever is later."
