## "AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEVELS OF STAFFING FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION OFFICERS."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Department of Energy and 4 Environmental Protection shall prepare a report concerning the 5 environmental conservation police of the Department of Energy and 6 Environmental Protection. Such report shall examine: (1) The number of 7 conservation police officers and special conservation police officers 8 appointed during the preceding four calendar years, (2) statistics on 9 calls for service by such conservation police officers during such four-10 year period, (3) statistics on the enforcement of all applicable statutory and regulatory provisions by such conservation police officers during 11 12 such four-year period, and (4) benchmarking of such staffing 13 information and enforcement statistics to other comparable states, as

14	available and appropriate. Not later than February 1, 2026, the		
15	department shall submit such report, in accordance with the provisions		
16	of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees		
17	of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the
