## "AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYERS TO DISPLAY A POSTER CONTAINING INFORMATION ON VETERANS' BENEFITS AND SERVICES."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2025) (a) The Labor Commissioner and the Chief Manufacturing Officer, in consultation 4 5 with the Commissioner of Veterans Affairs, shall, within available 6 appropriations, post information on the Internet web sites of the Labor 7 Department and the Office of Manufacturing concerning benefits and services available to veterans in the state. Such information shall be in a 8 9 form available for downloading by an employer to display at such 10 employer's place of business.

(b) An employer may display such information in a conspicuousplace, accessible to employees, at the employer's place of business."
