"AN ACT REQUIRING A PLAN FOR THE TRANSLATION AND REVIEW OF ALL FORMS AND APPLICATIONS REQUIRED TO ACCESS STATE AGENCY SERVICES OR BENEFITS BY LIMITED-ENGLISH PROFICIENT INDIVIDUALS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the 2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) As used in this section, (1) 4 "individual with limited-English proficiency" means an individual 5 whose primary and preferred language is not English, and who has a limited ability to read, speak, write or understand English, (2) "vital 6 7 record" has the same meaning as provided in section 7-36 of the general 8 statutes, and (3) "identification document" means a document that can 9 be used to verify the holder's identity, including, but not limited to, a 10 driver's license.

11 (b) Not later than January 1, 2026, the office of the Governor shall

12	develop a plan for the review and translation of printed or electronic	
13	forms or applications required to access services or benefits provided by	
14	executive branch state agencies, including, but not limited to, all forms	
15	or applications necessary to access vital records or to obtain	
16	identification documents, into the twelve most common non-English	
17	languages spoken by individuals with limited-English proficiency in the	
18	state based on the data in the most recent American Community Survey	
19	published by the United States Census Bureau."
