**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF QUOTAS BY WAREHOUSE
DISTRIBUTION CENTERS."**

1 Strike section 8 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 8. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2025*) (a) On and after July 1, 2026,
3 an employee or former employee aggrieved by a violation of sections 2
4 to 7, inclusive, of this act, may bring a civil action in the Superior Court
5 to recover damages, civil penalties and such injunctive relief as the court
6 deems appropriate. Any party who prevails in such civil action may be
7 awarded reasonable attorney's fees and costs to be taxed by the court.

8 (b) An employer who violates a provision of sections 2 to 7, inclusive,
9 of this act may be assessed a civil penalty by the court of (1) one
10 thousand dollars for a first violation, (2) two thousand dollars for a
11 second violation, or (3) three thousand dollars for a third or subsequent
12 violations."
