## "AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT, FIREARMS PERMITS AND ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES AND SELF-DEFENSE."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The Special Licensing and Firearms Unit within the Department of Emergency Services and Public 4 5 Protection shall study errors made during the criminal history background check process, including checks that failed to identify a 6 7 disqualifying conviction due to record lapses or other system 8 inconsistences. On or before January 1, 2026, the unit shall submit a 9 report of its findings and any recommendations to the joint standing 10 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters 11 relating to public safety and security, in accordance with the provisions 12 of section 11-4a of the general statutes."
