"AN ACT CONCERNING VARIOUS REVISIONS TO THE MONEY TRANSMISSION STATUTES, STATE PAYMENTS AND INVESTMENTS IN VIRTUAL CURRENCY AND MINORS' MONEY SHARING APPLICATION ACCOUNTS."

1 Strike lines 571 to 590, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the 2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(b) On and after October 1, 2025, no licensee shall allow an 4 individual to sponsor, open or establish a money sharing application 5 account for or on behalf of a minor unless such licensee has (1) received 6 an attestation from such individual attesting that such individual is such 7 minor's parent or legal guardian, and (2) (A) received a copy of such 8 individual's motor vehicle operator's license or other valid government-9 issued identification card, or (B) verified the identity of such individual 10 in accordance with the provisions of the Bank Secrecy Act, 31 USC 5311 11 et seq., as amended from time to time, and the regulations promulgated

12 thereunder.

13 (c) (1) Not later than thirty business days after a licensee receives a 14 request from a minor or such minor's parent or legal guardian to delete 15 such minor's money sharing application account with such licensee, the 16 licensee shall delete such minor's money sharing application account 17 and cease processing such minor's personal data except where the 18 preservation of such minor's money sharing application account or 19 personal data is otherwise permitted or required by applicable law, 20 including, but not limited to, sections 42-515 to 42-525, inclusive, of the 21 general statutes. A licensee may extend such thirty-business-day period 22 by an additional thirty business days if such extension is reasonably 23 necessary considering the complexity and number of the minor's, 24 parent's or legal guardian's requests, provided the licensee informs the 25 minor or such minor's parent or legal guardian, as applicable, within the 26 initial thirty-business-day response period of such extension and the 27 reason for such extension."
