***"AN ACT CONCERNING CANNABIS, HEMP AND TOBACCO  
REGULATION."***

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) (a) Not later than October 1,  
4 2025, and annually thereafter, the owner of a mobile manufactured  
5 home park, as defined in section 21-64 of the general statutes, shall  
6 submit a report to the local fire marshal disclosing the water capacity  
7 and flow of each fire hydrant located in such park.

8 (b) If the local fire marshal finds, after reviewing the report submitted  
9 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, that any fire hydrant located  
10 in the mobile manufactured home park has insufficient water capacity  
11 or flow, or is otherwise not in working order, the local fire marshal shall  
12 report such local fire marshal's finding (1) in the form of a complaint to  
13 the Department of Consumer Protection, and (2) to the Mobile  
14 Manufactured Home Advisory Council established under section 21-

15 84a of the general statutes.

16 Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) Section 15 of house bill 6855 of the  
17 current session, as amended by House Amendment Schedule "A", shall  
18 take effect July 1, 2025."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
