***"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM
ENDING JUNE 30, 2027, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS
THEREFOR, AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO REVENUE AND
OTHER ITEMS IMPLEMENTING THE STATE BUDGET."***

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) (a) Any person who has
4 received gender-affirming health care services, as defined in section 52-
5 571m of the general statutes, when under the age of eighteen years, shall
6 have a cause of action against any licensed health care provider as
7 defined in section 52-184e of the general statutes, who provided such
8 person such gender-affirming health care services, and such person's
9 parent, as defined in section 46b-451 of the general statutes, who
10 consented to the provision of such gender-affirming health care services
11 on behalf of such person, if such person has: (1) Reached the age of
12 eighteen, and (2) suffered permanent physical or psychological injury
13 from the provision of such gender-affirming health care services.

14 (b) Any person described in subsection (a) of this section may bring
15 an action in the Superior Court to recover damages.

16 (c) No action to recover damages as described in subsections (a) and
17 (b) of this section may be brought later than thirty years from the date
18 such person attains the age of twenty-one."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
