After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2025) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, no mortgagee or mortgage servicer 4 5 shall refuse to accept or apply any partial mortgage payment made by a mortgagor for the unpaid balance on a mortgage loan, including 6 7 principal, interest and other charges properly assessed pursuant to the 8 loan documentation of such mortgage loan. As used in this section, 9 "mortgagee", "mortgage servicer", "mortgagor" and "mortgage loan" 10 have the same meanings as provided in section 49-8a of the general 11 statutes."
