## "AN ACT CONCERNING RESOURCES AND SUPPORTS FOR INFANTS, TODDLERS AND DISCONNECTED YOUTHS."

Strike sections 5 and 6 in their entirety and renumber the remaining
sections and internal references accordingly

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections andinternal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) Not later than December 1, 6 2025, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall 7 establish and implement an annual program to provide grants-in-aid to 8 municipalities to offset costs related to conducting criminal history 9 background checks on municipal camp staff members employed by 10 such municipalities and other safety measures at such camps. The 11 secretary shall (1) develop (A) eligibility criteria for such program, (B)

- 12 an application process for participation in such program, (C) a formula
- 13 for awarding grants-in-aid, and (D) guidelines for the acceptable use of
- 14 grants-in-aid, and (2) award each eligible municipality an amount not
- 15 to exceed five thousand dollars per municipality. Not later than January
- 16 1, 2026, and annually thereafter, the secretary shall notify municipalities
- 17 of the availability of grants-in-aid under the program."
