***"AN ACT CONCERNING RESOURCES AND SUPPORTS FOR
INFANTS, TODDLERS AND DISCONNECTED YOUTHS."***

1 Strike subsection (a) of section 3 in its entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(a) Not later than January 1, 2025, and [annually] biennially
4 thereafter, the executive board of the Connecticut Preschool Through
5 Twenty and Workforce Information Network, established pursuant to
6 section 10a-57g of the general statutes, shall submit [an annual] a report
7 on disconnected youth. In developing such report, the executive board
8 shall use the data model established through the data sharing agreement
9 0043 regarding Research on Disengaged and Disconnected Youth in
10 Connecticut. The executive board shall submit such report to the (1) joint
11 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
12 matters relating to education, children, the judiciary, labor, human

13 services, public health and appropriations, (2) Connecticut Advisory
14 Commission on Intergovernmental Relations, established pursuant to
15 section 2-79a of the general statutes, and (3) Two-Generational Advisory
16 Board, established pursuant to section 17b-112/ of the general statutes,
17 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.
18 On or after January first, and prior to February first, of the year
19 following the submission of the report, the joint standing committees
20 described in subdivision (1) of this subsection shall hold a hearing on
21 the report. As used in this section, "disconnected youth" has the same
22 meaning as provided in section 21 of [this act] public act 24-25."
