"AN ACT CONCERNING RESOURCES AND SUPPORTS FOR INFANTS, TODDLERS AND DISCONNECTED YOUTHS."

Strike sections 5 and 6 in their entirety and renumber the remaining
sections and internal references accordingly

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections andinternal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) On and after June 1, 2026, any 6 municipal agency that establishes, conducts or maintains a youth camp, 7 as defined in section 19a-420 of the general statutes, shall annually 8 require any prospective employee applying for a position at such 9 program that requires the provision of care to a child or involves 10 unsupervised access to a child, to submit to a comprehensive 11 background check as described in section 19a-421 of the general

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
