"AN ACT PROHIBITING LIBRARIES FROM AGREEING TO CERTAIN TERMS IN ELECTRONIC BOOK AND DIGITAL AUDIOBOOK LICENSE AGREEMENTS OR CONTRACTS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) Each library, as defined in
4 section 1 of this act, that possesses pornographic material shall establish
5 a separate section for such pornographic material that is accessible only
6 to individuals who are eighteen years of age or older. As used in this
7 section, "pornographic material" means any work (1) depicting sexual
8 activity or nudity in a manner intended to cause sexual arousal or
9 excitement, and (2) when taken as a whole, appeals to the prurient
10 interest and lacks any serious literary, artistic, political or scientific
11 value."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
