**"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE HIGHER
EDUCATION STATUTES CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
THE CONNECTICUT STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND THE
BOARD OF REGENTS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) Prior to the execution of an
4 employment contract with any employee of the Connecticut State
5 Colleges and Universities or the Board of Regents for Higher Education
6 with a salary in an amount greater than four hundred thousand dollars,
7 said board shall file such contract with the clerks of the House of
8 Representatives and the Senate. The General Assembly may approve
9 such contract, in whole, by a majority vote of each house or may reject
10 such contract, in whole, by a majority vote of either house. If rejected,

11 the contract shall not be valid. The contract shall be deemed rejected if
12 the General Assembly fails to vote to approve or reject the contract (1)
13 prior to the adjournment of the regular session of the General Assembly
14 during which such contract is filed, (2) prior to the adjournment of the
15 regular session of the General Assembly first following the date on
16 which such contract is filed if the General Assembly is not in regular
17 session on such date, or (3) prior to the adjournment of a special session
18 convened before the next regular session of the General Assembly for
19 the purpose of considering such contract if the General Assembly is not
20 in regular session on the date on which such contract is filed."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
