"AN ACT CONCERNING ROAMING DOGS."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
 internal references accordingly:

"Sec. 501. Subsection (h) of section 14-296aa of the general statutes is
repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*1, 2025):

6 (h) Any person who violates this section shall be fined [two hundred] 7 <u>not more than three hundred fifty</u> dollars for a first violation [, three 8 hundred seventy-five dollars for a second violation and six hundred 9 twenty-five dollars for a third or subsequent violation] <u>and not more</u> 10 <u>than five hundred dollars for a second violation. Any subsequent</u> 11 violation of this section shall be a class C misdemeanor."
