**"AN ACT CONCERNING ROAMING DOGS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (h) of section 14-296aa of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*  
5 *1, 2025*):

6 (h) Any person who violates this section shall be fined [two hundred]  
7 not more than three hundred fifty dollars for a first violation [, three  
8 hundred seventy-five dollars for a second violation and six hundred  
9 twenty-five dollars for a third or subsequent violation] and not more  
10 than five hundred dollars for a second violation. Any subsequent  
11 violation of this section shall be a class C misdemeanor."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
