#### AN ACT EXCLUDING VETERANS' FEDERAL SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR PURPOSES OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE FROM A PUBLIC DEFENDER.

## SUMMARY

This bill requires excluding a person's service-connected disability benefits administered by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs from consideration under the guidelines public defenders use to determine indigency and eligibility for public defender services.

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2025

## BACKGROUND

## Definition of an Indigent Defendant

By law, an "indigent defendant" is an adult charged with a crime; a child who has a right to counsel in a juvenile matter; or a parent, guardian, or other person in certain cases, who does not have the financial ability to secure competent legal representation and pay necessary expenses of legal representation.

# Calculation of Income to Determine Eligibility for a Public Defender

By law, the commission is required to make annual guidelines. A person's income, which must be calculated according to the guidelines and that is 250% or less of the federal poverty level, may qualify as an indigent defendant.
