Title: AN ACT AUTHORIZING LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO HOLD CERTAIN UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS PURSUANT TO AN ICE DETAINER REQUEST.

Statement of Purpose: To authorize state and local law enforcement agencies to hold an undocumented immigrant pursuant to an ICE detainer request, up to forty-eight hours, and without a judicial warrant, when such person has been charged with a class A, B or C felony or crime of family violence.
