**Title:** AN ACT ELIMINATING THE AGE REQUIREMENT FOR DRIVERS WHO COMPLETE AN ACCIDENT PREVENTION COURSE AND REQUIRING A STUDY OF AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE LAWS IN OTHER STATES.
