Title: AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PROTECTIONS FOR CERTAIN HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS.

Statement of Purpose: To require that any stop-loss insurance policy used in conjunction with a self-funded employee health benefit plan: (1) Provide coverage for (A) essential health benefits as defined in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, and regulations adopted thereunder, and (B) the group state-mandated coverage requirements under chapter 700c of the general statutes; or (2) have (A) a minimum individual attachment point of not less than seventy-five thousand dollars, and (B) an aggregate attachment point of not less than two hundred fifty thousand dollars.
