Title: AN ACT CONCERNING AUDITS CONDUCTED BY THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION.

Statement of Purpose: To require (1) the selection process for State Elections Enforcement Commission audits be open to the public, (2) the commission to complete and issue findings concerning a post-primary or post-election audit of a campaign not later than twelve months after receiving all necessary information, and (3) the commission to submit an annual report concerning all audits that were not completed within such twelve-month period.
