No Fiscal Impact

The amendment alters the impact of the underlying amendment by changing the reporting requirements for housing authorities which is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the state or municipalities.

Local housing authorities are autonomous public corporations, which are generally funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) but may also receive state funding.
