### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

The amendment eliminates sections 9 and 10 of the underlying bill as amended and the associated fiscal impact.

This eliminates various potential costs to municipalities, the Office of Policy and Management (OPM), the Department of Housing, and the Connecticut Housing Finance Authority associated with priority affordable housing plans and grant program.

This also eliminates a potential revenue shift that may have occurred by prioritizing certain municipalities for discretionary infrastructure funding and potential revenue gain associated with the grant program.

The amendment also eliminates a potential cost to OPM associated with determining a municipality's fair share of housing.
