OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment eliminates sections 22 through 29 of the underlying bill as amended and the associated fiscal impact.

This eliminates an annual cost to the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) of approximately \$212,300 beginning in FY 26 for two additional positions and a one-time cost of \$4,200 in FY 26 for equipment. It also eliminates the corresponding annual cost of \$87,200 to the Office of the State Comptroller beginning in FY 26 for fringe benefits.

This also eliminates (1) other various potential costs to OPM associated with a grant program and a study of wastewater, and (2) a potential cost to municipalities associated with establishing and meeting the requirements for transit-oriented communities.
