Potential Revenue Gain

The amendment requires applicants for certain proposed affordable housing development to provide a \$100,000 surety bond with their application. This results in a potential revenue gain to municipalities beginning in FY 26 to the extent that municipalities take action to collect the surety bond if and when developers withdraw an application.
