The amendment eliminates section 32 of the underlying bill as amended and its associated fiscal impact and replaces it with the following.

Section 32 requires any hearing held by a fair rent commission to be considered a contested case and to meet other various requirements. This may result in a potential cost to municipalities to the extent fair rent commissions require additional resources to meet these requirements.
