Potential Savings

Section 501 expands the types of housing units that are counted toward the ten percent threshold under which municipalities are no longer subject to the affordable housing appeals procedure to include all mobile manufactured homes located in mobile manufactured home parks. This may result in a potential savings to municipalities associated with legal costs to the extent there are fewer appeals.
