## ***OFA Fiscal Note***

### ***See Fiscal Note Details***

The amendment requires municipalities with watershed land to be prioritized for discretionary infrastructure funding in a manner similar to those with a priority affordable housing plan. This may result in a potential revenue shift associated with prioritizing discretionary funding. This may result in some towns receiving larger grants and some receiving smaller grants. Any shift is dependent on how funding is prioritized.
