The amendment makes the Department of Public Health (DPH) (in consultation with the Commissioner of Housing) the agency responsible for developing and administering a portable shower and laundry facility pilot program (previously the Department of Social Services), resulting in a cost to DPH of at least \$300,000 in FY 26 and \$200,000 in FY 27.
