OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Cost

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. The amendment requires the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to establish an extended producer responsibility program for various solar panels and commercial wind turbine components. Producers of various solar panels and commercial wind turbine components must submit a plan to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) by July 1, 2027, and the program must be implemented by January 1, 2028. To the extent that the plan includes additional responsibilities or requires additional staffing for DEEP, there could be a potential state cost. The scope of the cost would be dependent upon the final plan.
