The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment results in an estimated annualized revenue gain of between \$200,000 and \$1 million from the elimination of the prohibition on sports betting with regard to Connecticut intercollegiate teams. This estimate assumes a net increase in gross gaming revenue of between 1% and 5% as a result.
