Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. The amendment expands existing protection from Freedom of Information Act disclosures for victims of domestic violence to victims of sexual assault and authorizes any discussion of shelters or transitional housing for sexual assault victims that would disclose the location of that shelter to be held in executive session, resulting in no fiscal impact.
