No Fiscal Impact

The amendment does not alter the bill's fiscal impact. It requires the Board of Regents for Higher Education to appoint a compliance officer, rather than establish an audit office, to perform auditing responsibilities. It also makes a clarifying change to the underlying bill's requirement for data sharing between the Office of the State Comptroller and the constituent units of higher education.
