The amendment changes the enforcement of violations of sections 2 to 7 of the underlying bill from the Superior Court to the Labor Department and decreases the civil penalty from up to \$3,000¹ to up to \$300². This decreases the potential revenue gain identified in the underlying fiscal note since fine amounts are decreased.
