OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Cost

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impacts. The amendment requires the Commissioner of Public Health to conduct a study and report on whether certain room selection, room arrangement and restroom usage provisions regarding nursing homes and managed residential communities conflict with any federal law. This results in a potential cost to the Department of Public Health in FY 26, to the extent outside legal expertise is required to perform this review.
