OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment exempts any school that has more than thirty percent of the student population that is eligible for the federal school lunch program from the provisions of section 1 of the underlying bill. This reduces the costs associated with schools needing to enter into new contracts with vendors identified in the fiscal note on the underlying bill as amended for schools meeting the criteria for the exemption.
